Waterford School District is located at the center of Oakland County in southeast Michigan, 31 miles northwest of Detroit. The district encompasses Waterford Township and portions of the surrounding townships of White Lake, West Bloomfield, Independence, and Lake Angelus. The district consists of 9 elementary, 2 middle, two senior high schools, and one alternative high school. Waterford is an established suburban residential community of nearly 80,000 residents. Waterford Mott High School is a public school which opened in 1970. Fall enrollment in 2018 is 1490 for grades 9-12. The school offers a comprehensive curriculum with an emphasis on college preparatory and career education courses. Students participate in a seven period day, which provides additional opportunities for students to choose electives and advanced courses. Mott has 67 classroom teachers, four counselors, and four administrators. All classroom teachers are highly qualified in one or more subject areas.
